



Christmas Surprises

Contents:

4 double sided festive boards, 24 shaped presents, 24 coloured bauble pieces, 1 shape dice, 1 colour dice.

SHAPES GAME

Set up

- Each player chooses a double sided festive board and places it in front of them with the Father Christmas picture uppermost.
- The shaped presents are spread out in the centre of the table with the wrapping paper side uppermost.
- The coloured bauble pieces and colour dice are not needed in this game.

Object

To be the first player to fill their board with the matching shapes.

To play

- The youngest player begins by rolling the shape dice and looking for a matching shaped present, which they place on the corresponding shape on their festive board (keeping it wrapping paper side up). If they have already covered that shape on their board, the piece is returned to the table, wrapping paper side uppermost.
- Play passes to the next player.
- Play continues until one player has covered all the shape spaces on their board.

The winner

The winner is the first player to cover all the shape spaces on their board with the matching shaped presents. At the end of the game, all players turn over their presents to reveal what Father Christmas has brought them!

COLOUR GAME

Set up

- Each player chooses a double sided festive board and places it in front of them with the Christmas tree picture uppermost.
- The coloured bauble pieces are spread out in the centre of the table, coloured side up.
- The shaped presents and shape dice are not needed in this game

Object

To be the first player to decorate their Christmas tree board with matching coloured baubles.

To play

- The youngest player begins by rolling the colour dice and looking for a matching coloured bauble, which they place on the corresponding colour on their festive board, coloured side up. If they have already covered that colour on their board, the piece is returned to the table, coloured side up.
- Play passes to the next player.
- Play continues until one player has covered all the coloured spaces on their board.

The winner

The winner is the first player to decorate their tree by covering all the coloured spaces with matching coloured baubles.
