

Teddy Bear Game

Contents:

24 teddy bear cards, 6 picnic basket picture cards, 4 picnic blanket boards, 1 colour spot dice

Setting up

- Each player chooses a picnic blanket board and places it in front of them.
- The teddy bear cards and the picnic basket picture cards are shuffled, then spread out, face down, in the centre of the table.

Object

To collect the most teddy bears on your picnic blanket before the picnic basket picture is completed.

To play

- The youngest player begins by rolling the colour spot dice and then turns over a matching coloured card from the table.
- If the card is a teddy bear card (showing a number and either one, two or three teddy bear images), they place it face up on their picnic blanket board. **N.B.** The cards showing the number zero have no teddy bear images on them and these cards are also placed on the picnic blanket board, when collected. Should a player fill their picnic blanket board with cards, then any further cards they collect are placed around the edge of the board.
- If the card is part of the picnic basket picture, then the player places it face up on the table, in reach of all players, to start assembling the picnic basket picture.
- If a player rolls the colour spot dice and there are no matching cards left on the table, then the player does not pick up a card on this turn.
- Play then moves on to the next person.
- As play progresses and other picnic basket picture cards are turned over, they should be added to the picnic basket picture.
- Play continues until the picnic basket picture is complete.
- Once the picture is complete, each player counts up how many teddy bears they have on their picnic blanket.

The winner

The winner is the player with the most teddy bears on their picnic blanket at the end of the game.



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
