



Smelly Wellies

Turn over smelly welly cards to find matching pairs of wellies for your monsters!

Contents

• 4 jiggled monster boards • 24 patterned welly cards

Setting up the game

Each player chooses a jiggled monster board and pieces it together.




Stack all the **red backed** welly cards into a pile **face down**.




Take turns to select three red backed welly cards and place them **pattern side up** on each of the monsters on your playing board. Set aside any remaining **red backed** wellies as they are not required.

Spread all the **green backed** welly cards **green side up** on the table. For an easier game, arrange the wellies in lines of four, as below.



1 Pick a welly

The youngest player starts.



Turn over a **green backed** welly card from the table.

2 Does the pattern match any of your wellies?

If the pattern on the welly **matches** any of the wellies on your monsters, place it on your monster so that it has a matching pair of wellies.



If the welly card **does not match**, show it to the other players and return it face down to the table. Play passes to the next player.

3 The winner!

The winner is the first player to find matching wellies for all their monsters and shout out "**Smelly Wellies!**"



For an easier game

This is a simple matching activity using just the welly cards. Spread all the welly cards pattern side up on the table and find the matching pairs.



For a more challenging game

- 1 Each player selects a jiggled monster playing board and pieces it together.
- 2 Spread all the welly cards **pattern side down** on the table, keeping the **green backed** welly cards and **red backed** welly cards separate from each other.
- 3 The first player turns over a **green backed** welly card followed by a **red backed** welly card. If the wellies **match**, place them on one of your monsters. If they **do not match** turn the cards back over. Play passes to the next player.
- 4 The first player to place matching wellies on all their monsters is the winner.
