

# Ten Green Bottles

## **Contents:**

4 jiggled wall boards, 40 green bottle cards (4 sets of numbers, 1 to 10), 40 spotty number cards (4 sets of numbers, 1 to 10), 1 3D bottle bank

## **Setting up**

- Each player makes up a wall board, places it on the table in front of them and places the bottles numbered 1 to 10, in order, across the top of the wall.
- The spotty cards are placed, face down in the centre of the table. NB If less than 4 players are playing the game, only use a 1-10 set of spotty number cards for each player (2 players = 20 cards, 3 players = 30 cards).
- The bottle bank is slotted together and placed in the centre of the table within easy reach of all players.

## **Object**

To be the first player to recycle all 10 of their green bottles.

## **To play**

- The youngest player starts by choosing one of the face down spotty cards from the table and counts the spots, ensuring that the other player/s have seen the card.
- If the number of spots on this card match the number shown on one of the bottle cards on the player's wall, both of these cards are posted into the bottle bank.
- If the number of spots on the revealed card are equal to a bottle that the player has already posted, then the spot card is returned to the table, face down.
- Play passes to the next player.
- When a player has only one bottle left on their wall and they turn over a spotty card matching the number on that bottle, that player is the winner and sing "There are NO green bottles standing on the wall" as they post the last two cards.

## **The winner**

The winner is the first player to recycle all their green bottles.
