

# How to sort your games

We have colour-coded the backing of each game to help you put them together. **Old MacDonald Game** playing board has a yellow backing, **Monster Dominoes** have a red backing, **Red Dog Colour Game** playing boards have a blue backing and **Jungle Snakes & Ladders** playing board has a green backing.

#### **Old MacDonald Game**

**To play this game you will need:** 1 jigged playing board, 24 coloured discs, 4 playing pieces, 1 colour spot dice **Setting up** 

- Piece together the playing board. Each player chooses a playing piece and places it on the Start space.
- Shuffle and spread out the coloured discs, colour side up, on the table.

**Object:** To be the player with the most animals at the end of the game.

#### To play

- The youngest player starts by rolling the colour spot dice and moving to the first matching coloured space along the
  path.
- Choose a matching coloured disc from the table and, without looking underneath, place it in front of you. Play passes
  to the next player.
- If you roll the dice and there are no matching coloured discs left, play passes immediately to the next player.
- If you land on a space with a gate on it, return one of your discs colour side up to the table, without looking at the
  other side of the card.
- Play continues until one player reaches the end space. N.B. A green must be rolled to finish the game.
- Once the game has ended, players turn over their coloured discs and count how many animals they have collected.

#### The winner

The winner is the player who has collected the most animals when the game finishes.

## **Monster Dominoes**

To play this game you will need: 28 domino cards

#### Setting up

Shuffle the dominoes and deal seven to each player, placing the remaining dominoes in a face down pile on the table. **Object:** To be the first person to play all your dominoes.

#### To play

- The youngest player starts by placing one of their dominoes, face up, in the middle of the table.
- Play continues with the next player matching a monster on one of their dominoes to either end of the domino chain.
   N.B. Dominoes must be placed on the table with the matching ends touching.
- If you are unable to match any dominoes, take one from the main pile and add it to your own. If this matches a domino
  in the centre, you must wait until your next turn to play it. Play passes to the next player.
- · If you are unable to match any dominoes and there are none in the central pile, play passes to the next player.
- The game continues until nobody can match any of their dominoes, or someone uses up all their dominoes.

#### The winner

The winner is the first player to play all of their dominoes or, if nobody can finish, the player with the fewest dominoes at the end of the game.

### **Red Dog Colour Game**

**To play this game you will need:** 4 playing boards, 24 coloured discs, 1 colour spot dice

#### Setting up

- Each player chooses a playing board.
- Shuffle the coloured discs and spread them out, colour side up, in the middle of the table.

**Object:** To be the first player to cover all of the coloured spots on your playing board with matching coloured discs. **To play** 

- The youngest player starts by rolling the colour spot dice and looking for a matching coloured disc. Place the disc over the matching coloured spot on your playing board. Play passes to the next player.
- If you roll a colour you have already collected, play passes to the next player.
- Play continues until one player has covered all the spots on their board.

### The winner

The winner is the first player to cover all of the coloured spots on their playing board with matching coloured discs.

## **Jungle Snakes & Ladders**

**To play this game you will need:** 1 jigged playing board, 4 playing pieces, 1 number spot dice **Setting up** 

Piece together the playing board. Each player chooses a playing piece and places it on the Start space.

Object: To be the first player to reach the monkey on the Finish space.

## To play

- The youngest player starts by rolling the dice and moving their playing piece the number of spaces shown. Play passes
  to the next player.
- If you land on a square that is at the bottom of a ladder, move your playing piece up to the top of the ladder. Play
  passes to the next player.
- If you land on a square showing a snake's head, move your playing piece down to the end of the snake's tail. Play
  passes to the next player.

## The winner

The winner is the first player to reach the monkey on the Finish space.
