

Frog Families

32 frog cards (8 sets of 4 matching coloured cards)

Object

Use your memory and communication skills to collect the most sets of four matching coloured frog cards.

Setting up

- All the cards are shuffled and dealt face down to the players.
- Players look at their cards. If they have any complete sets of matching coloured frog cards (guitar, drum, saxophone & singer) they should lay the set on the table in front of them before play begins.

How to play

- Players take it in turns to ask any other player for one of the cards they need to help complete a set e.g. "Please may I have the green card with the frog singing?". The player asking must already hold one card from the coloured set they are trying to complete.
- If the asked player holds the card that was requested, they must give it to the requester who adds it to their cards. The requester can then ask any player for another card.
- If the asked player does not hold the card requested they say "hop along" and it becomes their turn to ask a player for a card.
- When a player has collected a set of matching coloured frog cards, they place it face up in front of them.
- Play continues until all the sets have been collected.

The winner

The winner is the player with the most sets of matching coloured frog cards at the end of the game.
