

Contents:

4 double-sided boards, 24 picture cards, 24 word cards

Setting up

- Each player chooses a double-sided board and places it in front of them.
- Choose which version of the game to play and spread out either the
 picture or word cards, face down, on the table. The picture cards are
 used in games 1 and 3. The word cards are used in games 2 and 4.

Object

To be the first player to collect all the picture/word cards on their lotto

To play Game 1 (match picture to picture)

This game is played with the **picture cards** and your **board turned picture side up**.

- The youngest player starts. Turn over a picture card.
- If the card matches a picture on your board, cover the picture with the card. Play passes to the next player.
- If the card does not match a picture on your board, show the card to the other players and return it face down to the table. Play passes to the next player.
- Play continues until one player has collected all the pictures on their board.

The winner

The winner is the first player to cover all the pictures on their lotto board.

To play Game 2 (match word to word)

This game is played as Game 1 using the word cards and your board turned word side up.

The winner

The winner is the first player to cover all the words on their lotto board with word cards.

To play Game 3 (match picture to word)

This game is played as Game 1 using the **picture cards** and your **board turned word side up**.

The winner

The winner is the first player to cover all the words on their lotto board with picture cards.

To play Game 4 (match word to picture)

This game is played as Game 1 using the word cards and your board turned picture side up.

The winner

The winner is the first player to cover all the pictures on their lotto board with word cards.
