

Contents:

30 egg cards, 4 nest boards, 1 spinner board, 1 two-part spinner (separate the plastic arrow from the base and attach to the spinner board)

Setting up

- Each player takes a nest board and places it in front of them.
- Spread all the cards, with the eggs face up, on the table.
- Place the spinner where everyone can reach it.

Object

To be the player with the most dinosaurs in your nest at the end of the game.

To play

- The youngest player starts by spinning the spinner and choosing an egg card showing the same number of eggs as the number on the spinner.
- Turn over the card and place it in front of you on your nest board. The card will show 1, 2, 3 or 4 dinosaurs on it.
- Play passes to the next player.
- If you cannot find a card with the matching number of eggs, play passes to the next player.
- If you turn over a T-Rex card, remove one of your dinosaur cards and place it to one side along with the T-Rex card. If you have no dinosaur cards in your nest, place the T-Rex card out of play to one side.
- Play continues until all the cards have been collected.
- At the end of the game, count up all the dinosaurs on your cards.

The winner

The winner is the player with the most dinosaurs!
