

Tiger Pairs

Contents:

32 tiger cards

Setting up

- Spread all the cards face down on the table.

Object

To collect the most tiger pairs by the end of the game.

To play

- Take it in turns to try and find a tiger pair by turning over two cards, leaving them face up on the table.
- If the cards are identical, place the matching pair in front of you.
- If the cards do not match, turn them back over.
- Your turn continues until you are unable to find a matching pair. Play then passes to the next player.
- The game ends when there are no cards left to pick up.

The winner

The winner is the player with the most tiger pairs at the end of the game.

Quick Play (for younger players)

- Remove eight sets of pairs before playing.

Single Player Activity

- For single players, place the cards face up or face down on the table and find the matching pairs of tigers.
