## GB) Matching Monkeys

## Contents:

8 tree cards, 24 vine cards, 1 dice

## Setting up

- Each player takes a tree card with a yellow backing and places it in front of them.
- Place the remaining tree and vine cards face down on the table with the bananas facing up.


## Object

To be the player with the most monkeys on their vine.

## To play

- The youngest player starts by rolling the dice and turning over a card with the matching number of bananas.
- If the card is a vine card, add it to your tree to start your vine.
- If the card is a tree AND you do not have a vine card already, return the tree to the table banana side up. Play passes to the next player.
- If you pick up a tree card and you already have one or more vines, add the tree to your vine. You can no longer extend your vine, but you can continue to roll the dice on your next turn. If you pick up a vine card on any of your next turns, place the card to one side. If you pick up a tree card you can add it to another player's vine to stop their vine.
- Play continues until all players have a tree at the end of their vine.
- At the end of the game, count up all the monkeys on your vine.


## The winner

The winner is the player with the most monkeys on their vine!
