

Contents:

30 door cards, 1 dice, 1 bear reference board

Setting up

- Spread the cards on the table with the doors facing upwards.
- Place the bear reference board where all players can see it.

Object

To collect the most cards by guessing the correct bear colour.

To play

- The youngest player starts by rolling the dice and choosing a door with a matching number.
- Before turning the card over, guess which coloured bear is hiding behind the door by saying e.g. "Knock, knock, who's there? I think it's red bear!"
- If you guess correctly, keep the card and place it in front of you. You can now have another turn. Roll the dice and try to guess another coloured bear.
- If you make an incorrect guess, return the card face down to the table. Play passes to the next player.
- Some cards show all of the bears. If you guess the colour of any of these bears, keep the card and place it in front of you.
- Play continues until all the cards have been taken.

The winner

The winner is the player with the most cards at the end of the game.
