

Giraffes in Scarves

How many scarves can you collect for your giraffe? Roll the dice, pick a card and build your giraffe in this fun counting and colour matching game!

Contents

• 24 neck cards • 6 head cards • 6 base boards • 1 colour dice

Setting up the game

Each player chooses a giraffe body. Place any unused bodies and matching heads (see Giraffe Reference Guide, bottom right) out of play.
















Spread the remaining neck and head cards face down on the table.





The youngest

Roll the dice

matching coloured spot.

Turn this card over.

If you roll the dice and there are no cards with matching coloured spots left, play passes to the next player.

lf you turn over a neck card...

If the card is a **neck card**, add it to your giraffe's neck.



Play passes to the next player.





If you turn over YOUR head card...

a) WITHOUT a neck card on your giraffe

If the **head card** matches **your** giraffe body but you **do not** have any neck cards (see image, right), return it face down to the table and mix up the cards.

Play passes to the next player.






b) WITH a neck card on your giraffe

If the **head card** matches **your** giraffe body and you have one or more neck cards (see image, right), place the head at the top of your giraffe's neck. You cannot add any more neck cards to your finished giraffe, but can continue to turn over cards on your next turn (see note at bottom).

Play passes to the next player.



If you turn over ANOTHER PLAYER'S head card...

a) When your own giraffe is UNFINISHED

If the head card matches another player's giraffe body and you do not have a finished giraffe, return the card face down to the table and mix up the cards.

Play passes to the next player.

b) When your own giraffe is **FINISHED**

If you turn over a **head card** which matches **another** player's giraffe body and your giraffe is already finished, place the head at the top of their giraffe. This will end their chances of adding any more scarves.

Please note: You can only do this if the player has one or more neck cards on their giraffe.

Play passes to the next player.



The winner

Play continues until all player's giraffes are finished.

Each player counts how many scarves their giraffe is wearing.

The winner is the player with the **most scarves** at the end of the game.





Once your giraffe is finished, you can still turn over cards on your turn to see if you can find another player's head.

However, if you turn over a neck card it must be taken out of play.
