GB Good Eggs

Contents:

30 good egg cards, 2 bad egg cards

Setting up

• Spread all the egg cards face down on the table.

Object

To be the player with the most pairs of eggs.

To play

- The youngest player begins by turning over two cards at random, leaving them on the table. If the cards are identical, pick them both up and place the matching pair in front of you. If the cards do not match, turn them back over.
- If you turn over a bad egg card then you must place the bad egg and a pair you have already collected out of play. If you have no pair cards, return the bad egg card, face down, to the table.
- Play then passes to the next player.
- The game ends when there are no cards left to pick up.

The winner

The winner is the player with the most good egg pairs at the end of the game.
