## GB Jelly Elephants

## Contents:

20 jelly cards, 20 bowl cards, 4 jelly elephant cards and 6 push-together image cards.

## Object

To be the player with the most jellies in their bowls at the end of the game.

## To play

- Shuffle the cards and place them face downwards in a pile in the middle of the table.
- The youngest player begins by taking a card from the top of the pile.
- If the player has picked a bowl card, in a colour they do not have, they place it in front of them. Otherwise the card is placed face upward on the discard pile in the middle of the table.
- If the player has picked a jelly card, the player matches the jelly to one of their empty bowls, that is the same colour as the jelly. If the player does not have a matching empty bowl, the jelly is returned to the discard pile, face upwards.
- If the player picks up a Jelly Elephant card, the player chooses a jelly from one of their bowls and places it in the discard pile, with the jelly elephant covering it.
- If the player picks a card, which is part of the 6-part picture puzzle, the player lays the card to the side of the table.
- Play then passes to the next player.
- On their turn, each player can choose to pick up from the main pile or pick up the top card from the discard pile.
- Play continues until the picture of the Jelly Elephant eating jellies is complete.


## The winner

The winner is the player with the most jellies in their bowls. In the event of a draw, the player with the most jellies in their bowls and the most empty bowls is the winner.
