

# **Knickerbocker Glory**

## **Contents:**

36 fruit cards, 6 knickerbocker glory boards, 1 colour spot dice, 1 number dice

## **Object**

To be the first player to make a knickerbocker glory.

## **To play**

- The fruit cards are broken out of the knickerbocker glory boards and spread face upwards in the centre of the table.
- Each player takes a knickerbocker glory board and places it in front of them. Players decide at the start of the game whether they want to play with the colour spot dice or number dice.
- The youngest player starts by throwing the dice. If using the colour spot dice, the player looks for a fruit card that is the same colour and places it in the correct position in their board.
- If using the number dice, the player looks for a fruit card that has the same number of fruit pieces on it and then places the card into the knickerbocker glory board.
- Play moves on to the next person.
- If a player rolls the dice and it stops on a number or colour that he has already collected, play moves on to the next person.
- Play continues until one player has filled their knickerbocker glory board with fruit.

## **The winner**

The winner is the first player to fill their knickerbocker glory board with fruit.
