

Contents:

1 jigged playing board, 1 dice, 24 pirate cards, 4 pirate playing pieces, 4 character stands

Setting up

- · Piece together the playing board.
- Insert each pirate playing piece into a character stand and place them on the pirate ship shown on the playing board.
- The pirate cards are shuffled and spread out face down on the table so the coloured spots can be seen.

Object

To be the first player to complete their pirate and race to the treasure.

To play

- The youngest player throws the dice and moves their chosen pirate playing piece around the board in a clockwise direction. They may then pick up a card that matches the coloured spot on which they have landed.
- If the card is part of the pirate they are collecting (the same colour as their pirate playing piece) they may keep it. If not, they show it to the other players and return it, face down, to the centre.
- If the player lands on a white spot with a red cross in it, they may choose to pick up any one of the coloured spot cards from the table. Play then passes to the person on their left.
- When players have completed their pirate, they continue around the board until they reach the footsteps, which they then follow to reach the treasure and win the game.

The winner

The winner is the first player to complete their pirate and race to the treasure, by following the footsteps to the treasure chest.
