# GB) On the Farm Dominoes 

## Contents:

28 dominoes

## Setting up

- Decide which side of the dominoes you are going to play with, either farm animals or dots.
- Shuffle the dominoes and deal seven to each player. Place the remaining dominoes in a pile, in the middle of the table, with the side being played with face down.


## Object

To be the first player to play all their dominoes.

## To play

- The youngest player starts by placing one of their dominoes, face up, in the middle of the table.
- Play continues with the person on the player's left matching a picture on one of their dominoes to one of the pictures on either end of the domino line. You must place your domino on the table with the matching ends touching. Play passes to the next player.
- If you are unable to play any of your dominoes, take a domino from the main pile and add it to your own. Play passes to the next player.
N.B. If there are no dominoes left in the pile, play passes to the next player.
- The game continues until nobody can match any of their dominoes, or someone uses up all their dominoes and wins the game.


## The winner

The winner is the first person to play all their dominoes or, if nobody can finish, the player with the fewest dominoes at the end of the game.
