Object

To collect the most matching pairs of cards.

To play

- The cards are shuffled and then spread face downwards on the table.
- The youngest player begins by turning over two cards on the table. If the cards make a matching pair, the player keeps the pair and places them in front of them and then turns over another two cards in an attempt to find another matching pair.
- If the two cards turned over are not the same, play passes to the next player.
- If a player turns over a pirate flag card, the player shouts,
 "Yo ho ho!" and takes a pair of cards from another player.
- If the player fails to shout "Yo ho ho!" the cards must be returned to the original player.
- The flag card is only discarded from the game when it has been turned over and used.
- If two flags are turned over, the cards are returned to the table.
- Play continues until all the cards have been taken from the table.

The winner

The winner is the player with the most pairs of cards at the end of the game.
